#### **GAE4DG Spiritual Director Message:**



"Here I am Lord. Is it I Lord? I have heard you calling in the night. I will go Lord. If you lead me. I will hold your people in my heart." (By Daniel Schutte) During the last Greater Austin Emmaus gathering held at University United Methodist the faithful gathered to praise God with songs and prayers. We heard a wonderful and uplifting 4th day message. We shared Holy Communion. That night we sang a rousing version of "Here I am Lord" and it was awesome! Just to be among so many Christians who

actually lifted their hands up to the Lord was amazing. What a glorious experience to gather in worship as the body of Christ. That night could not have been any better...Except... Well... The truth of the matter is that the crowd was pretty light. We missed so many of our Emmaus/Chrysalis/Kairos brothers and sisters that night!

According to the Upper Room, the Fourth Day is a symbol of the days of Christian pilgrimage that follow the three-day Emmaus experience. During the Walk to Emmaus we had the unique opportunity to reflect on our faith journey and make a deeper commitment to Christ. In fact, "the whole reason for The Walk to Emmaus is to make you a more faithful disciple and active member in your church." The general format at the web site is a list of instructions at the top of the page, followed by a grid of 6 columns with many rows for the items needed. The list of items is in alphabetical order. If you want to search for a particular item, you can enter <Control-F>, enter the name in the Find box, and press the Next button.

Approximately one week prior to the beginning of a Walk, a reminder e-mail will be sent to you for each item that you have promised to bring. The drop-off locations will be listed in the reminder e-mail.

#### LOCAL LAY DIRECTOR ORIENTATION (LLDO)

August 28, 2010 8:30a-12:30p First United Methodist Church, Pflugerville

If you are scheduled to serve on a GAE4DG Walk leadership team in 2010/2011; if you are interested in serving as a Walk LD at some time in the future; or if you are just really curious about what it takes for an Emmaus Walk to happen, please plan to attend the upcoming Local Lay Director Orientation (LLDO) scheduled for Aug. 28, 2010. The LLDO focuses on local (GAE) Walk details and issues, site specifics, and local Board support. Although the LLDO is not mandatory, your GAE4DG Board strongly urges that upcoming Walk LDs, BdReps, ALDs and SD's (if possible) attend - you'll get a wealth of helpful information, and many of your questions will be answered. It would also be helpful for the Servant Team Coordinators to attend as they need to be cognizant of some recent policy changes and unique "quirks" at local Walk sites.

Note: This training does NOT replace the Walk/Flight Leadership Training (W/FLT) which is conducted by the Southwest Texas Conference Emmaus Community and is mandatory for Walk Lay Directors, Board Reps, and Spiritual Directors. The W/FLT focuses on the UR and SWTC manuals and guidelines; the LLDO focuses on local procedures and site issues.

#### Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, July 1, 2010 at University United Methodist Church. In attendance were: Gene McConnell – Lay Director; Bob Duplantis – Member Support; Myles McKemie – Gathering Support; Diane Merwarth – Walk Support; Bud Broeker – Board Rep; Pastor Cheryl Broome – Spiritual Director; Roxie Greenway – Treasurer; Sandy Brooks – Assistant Lay Director; Jim Anthony and Gary Johnson.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Gene McConnell, with an opening prayer by Diane Merwarth. The minutes of the previous Board Meeting were approved as read by a motion by Diane Merwarth, seconded by Bud Broeker.

The finance report was presented and was approved unanimously upon a motion by Bud Broeker with a second from Diane Merwarth.

Ending balance as of 6/31/10: \$5,078.21.

Gene McConnell reported that an election would be held by written ballot at the gathering to elect a new Board Rep. The candidates included Jim Anthony and Tom Rioux. Gene also announced that Walk/Flight Leadership Training would take place on July 31 at Kerrville, Texas and that participants could car pool from Lake Travis UMC. Team selection for the February and March walks will be scheduled for August by the newly elected Board Rep. There will be Local Lay Director Training on August 28.

Roxie Greenway provided a hand out outlining the various board positions and their responsibilities and committee positions. The Board agreed that each board position would begin to fill their committee positions.

Gene McConnell will write the Lay Directors article for the August Walk Talk and announced that the Board will rotate writing this article.

Myles McKemie reported that the schedule for the 2010 gatherings was set, except for December. The August gathering will be at Covenant UMC, the September gathering will be at North West Hills UMC and the October gathering will be at Wesley UMC.

Diane Merwarth reported that the agape lists for the upcoming walks are available. She will also provide scholarship applications and pilgrim applications at the table at the gatherings.

Bob Duplantis will be contacting the Upper Room for the non-profit designation certificate.

The Board discussed the SW Conference request to present "The Gift" at welcome back gatherings. The Board voted to have Jack Foreman and Gene McConnell draft a letter in response to this request.

Myles McKemie agreed to obtain bids for recruiting signs for each church in the Greater Austin Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Community.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 to attend the gathering. The closing prayer was given by Pastor Cheryl Broome.
