### **Information for Camp Young Judaea**


GAE4DG will hold the upcoming Men's Walk 1580, Women's Walk 1593, and the 2011 Walks at the Camp Young Judaea site. Some may have been on a Walk or worked a team at this site before and for others this may be a totally new site to experience. Camp Young Judaea (CYJ) is a Jewish camp located near Wimberley off FM 12. Map and Driving Directions are given below. Website is http://www.cyjtexas.org/

This is a very beautiful site with many amenities. The CYJ staff is very excited to have us come to their campus. CYJ has worked closely with GAE4DG and Hays Praise Emmaus to make us feel welcome and to setup the guidelines as needed. The Dining Hall / Conference Center is a designated Kosher building and our community must honor the Kosher Laws within this building. For the purposes of Emmaus use of the Dining Hall / Conference Center, we will simple <u>not</u> bring any food into the building and for no reason use the kitchen in this building. The agape room has a full size kitchen to be used for food agape (did I hear servant teams cheering?).

#### What does this mean for the community?

Candlelight and Closing are planned to be at the <u>Conference Center</u>. So we ask the community to simple do not bring any outside food or drink into the building. Communion elements will be provided at the site. GAE4DG also will be providing the snacks for candlelight childcare, if available, to ensure the Kosher status. All food agape must be dropped off at the designated agape room. Or simple ask a team member or board member if you have any question on the guidelines.

Our teams for the upcoming Walks will learn the logistics of the new site and receive the Kosher Guidelines. As we learn about this site with the next few Walks, lets simple give Thanks to the Lord for providing new opportunities for us to serve and sponsor new pilgrims. De Colores!



#### From Austin:

Take MOPAC (Loop 1) South to 290 West toward Johnson City. About 15 miles outside of Austin, at the Dripping Springs traffic light (immediately after Home Depot) turn left onto Ranch Road 12. After about 14 miles take a right at the Woodcreek Drive traffic light to enter The City of Woodcreek. Go down Woodcreek Drive and turn right at the stop sign onto Brookhollow. Then take the 3rd left onto Jack Miller Drive. Straight ahead you'll see the gate to camp! Welcome to CYJ!

#### Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, August 5, 2010 at Covenant United Methodist Church. In attendance were: Gene McConnell – Lay Director; Myles McKemie – Gathering Support; Diane Merwarth – Walk Support; Pastor Cheryl Broome – Spiritual Director; Roxie Greenway – Treasurer; Sandy Brooks – Assistant Lay Director.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Gene McConnell, with an opening prayer by Sandy Brooks. The minutes of the previous Board Meeting were approved as read by a motion by Myles McKemie, seconded by Roxie Greenway.

The finance report was presented and was approved unanimously upon a motion by Gene McConnell with a second from Diane Merwarth.

Ending balance as of 7/31/10: \$5,173.21.

Gene McConnell reported that the SW Conference will be flexible on the presentation of "The Gift". Gene also announced there will be Local Lay Director Training on August 28.

The Board addressed the handout provided by Roxie Greenway at the previous board meeting. Diane Merwarth reported that she is looking for help on walk weekend follow up calls.

Myles McKemie reported that the schedule for the gatherings was set through March. The September gathering will be at North West Hills UMC, the October gathering will be at Wesley UMC, the November gathering will be at Oak Hill UMC and the December gathering will be at The Rock. Myles also agreed to send out the current POC list to all board members.

The Board reviewed the Kosher guidelines provided by Bob Duplantis.

Myles McKemie reported that he was talking with a company to provide recruiting signs for each church in the Greater Austin Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Community. Myles will also report back to the board on Emmaus Sunday Details. SD Cheryl Broome will contact Austin district pastors to invite them to celebrate an Emmaus Sunday at least once a year. Roxie Greenway agreed to look into setting up an Austin Emmaus Facebook account.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 to attend the gathering. The closing prayer was given by Gene McConnell.

#### HOW TO SPONSOR OTHERS

This is taken from DAY FOUR: The Pilgrim's Continued Journey

- 1. Pray for the person's openness to God's call to discipleship, not for how to get him or her to go on a walk.
- 2. Make an appointment with the person or couple for the purpose of discussing their participation in Emmaus.
- 3. Extend an invitation. Invite them to attend for the sake of a more vital relationship with Jesus Christ, not jus a weekend to go on. Share your faith; explain the basic elements of the walk, its purpose and follow up dimensions which help us live in grace for the rest of our lives. Have the attitude that you are giving them a wonderful gift rather than that they need to go.
- 4. Ask them to make a commitment by filling out the registration form. If the person is married, speak with both partners and encourage an equal commitment by both spouses.
- 5. Continue to pray, prepare agape letters, enlist the support of their pastor. Collect eight to twelve personal agape letters. Do not ask the team to deliver personal gifts during the weekend.
- **6.** Support the Walk through your prayers during the 72 hour prayer vigil and your presence at the send off, sponsors hour, Candlelight, and Closing. Support the Pilgrim's family by house sitting, babysitting, and watering plants, picking up the mail, feeding pets or just checking in with the spouse to see if any help is needed.
- 7. Encourage the Pilgrim in his or her Fourth day involvement. Give your friend an opportunity to talk through and appropriate the experience. Help them find a group. Or, be prepared to start a group with him or her for a period of time until they find others to be in the group. Take them to Gatherings as your guest for a couple of months.
- 8. Help the pilgrim reenter their Church and consider ways to act out new commitment and enthusiasm.
- 9. Inform the Pilgrim of how he or she can serve the Emmaus community and future walks.
- 10. Help the Pilgrim sponsor others.

Sponsorship is an act of love for God, for the Pilgrims, for the Emmaus Community, and for the church. It is a demonstration of agape love. It is making oneself an instrument of prevenient Grace.

It is recommend by the Upper Room and the SWTC Emmaus Registrar that recent Walk to Emmaus attendees wait 6 months before sponsoring their first Pilgrim. It is also recommended by the SWTC Emmaus Registrar that a Sponsor should sponsor no more than one to two pilgrims on a single Walk.
