

Simultaneously two people

We concentrate on one at the expense of the other to our own peril

A young man applying to Princeton University some years ago seemed to have a firm grip on honesty. When asked on the application to list his personal strengths, he wrote: "Sometimes I am trustworthy, courageous, loyal, helpful, friendly, kind, wise, thrifty and cheerful." (Must have been a Boy Scout)

Further down on the form, when asked to note some weaknesses, he wrote: "Sometimes I am not trustworthy, courageous, etc...."

Self-perspective is hard to come by in this life. One minute we think we're God's gift to the human race. The next minute we recognize what a jumbled mess we've made of different relationships and how miserably we have failed God. We live all-put-together lives and still leave footprints of hypocrisy every place we walk. We are rich and powerful beyond measure, yet empty and weak just the same.

Alexander Solzhenitsyn, the Russian dissident who witnessed every facet of human nature while in the gulag, knew our universal condition: "If only there were evil people somewhere insidiously committing evil deeds and it were necessary only to separate them from the rest of us and destroy them. But the line of dividing good and evil cuts through the heart of every human being."

We are heirs of a precious insight. One winter while wrestling with the third and fourth chapters of Romans, Martin Luther discovered that we are not mostly good and partially bad. We are completely loving and completely lousy -- both at the same time. We are wholly saint and wholly sinner.

We are whole people -- wholly redeemed and wholly sinful, never one without the other. We are the apple of God's eye, yet our behavioral report card is anything but commendable. At first, this paradox may appear too bizarre to grasp. But every good parent who must deal with a tough teenager knows what it's like to also love that same child as if there were no tomorrow.

These constantly side-by-side conditions offer a wonderful dynamism for the Christian life. The trick, of course, is not to ignore one at the expense of the other. Neither smugness nor self-denigration work well for faithful living. The challenge is to make sure we never favor one side over the other.

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, September 2, 2010 at Northwest Hills United Methodist Church. In attendance were: Gene McConnell – Lay Director; Bob Duplantis – Member Support; Myles McKemie – Gathering Support; Diane Merwarth – Walk Support; Jim Anthony – Board Rep; Pastor Cheryl Broome – Spiritual Director; Sandy Brooks – Assistant Lay Director; Roxie Greenway – Treasurer and Jack Foreman – Past Lay Director.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Gene McConnell, with an opening prayer by Diane Merwarth. The minutes of the previous Board Meeting were approved as read by a motion by Bob Duplantis, seconded by Diane Merwarth.

The treasurer's report was presented by Roxie Greenway and was approved unanimously upon a motion by Jack Foreman with a second from by Bob Duplantis.

Ending balance as of 8/31/10: \$7,116.08.

Roxie reported that Walk 1555 has been resolved and that an amended report to conference will result in \$45 to be paid to Chrysalis.

Jim Anthony reported the "The Gift" will be handled as each 4th Day Community chooses. A handout about "The Gift" will be included in each closing packet. No amount of donation will be suggested. Bob Duplantis agreed to edit the current hand out and will send it to the Board via email. The revised hand out will be approved for distribution prior to the next walk.

Roxie Greenway recommended that twice a year, the 4th Day Community will donate the money collected at the gathering to The Gift. The Board agreed to consider this recommendation at a later date.

Jim Anthony referred to the break even analysis previously sent to the Board. This analysis is used to set pricing for upcoming walks. Based on this analysis, walks Camp Young Judea for 2011 will be \$210.

Jim reported that the Spiritual Director and Assistant Spiritual Directors on walks are also to be progressive service. After discussion by the Board, it was agreed that Pastor Cheryl Broome will work with the Conference database in meeting this requirement.

Bob Duplantis addressed the concern that the current database for team selection is not current, particularly for people who served on walks in the Hays Praise community. Sandy Brooks agreed to review the database to identify persons who may have served in the Hays Praise community and work to have these individuals provide their previous experience on walks to be included in the database.

Jim reported that the question of local pastors was addressed and that local pastors can be Assistant Spiritual Directors on walks, but not Spiritual Directors. He further reported that in the Emmaus service, The Great Thanksgiving is to be given in its entirety by clergy.

Gene McConnell announced that Walk/Flight Training is scheduled for October 2 in Corpus Christi, November 13 in San Antonio and February 26 in Manchaca.

Gene McConnell asked the Board for open leadership positions. Myles McKemie reported that he still needs a host church coordinator and a communion steward. Bob Duplantis reported concern for coordinating reunion groups and the need for a Reunion Group Coordinator. Data on reunion groups can be collected through each church's point of contact. Bob Duplantis will follow up. Myles McKemie reported that he still needs a child care coordinator for gatherings and for candlelight.

Myles McKemie announced that the October gathering will be at Wesley UMC, the November gathering will be at Oak Hill UMC, and the December gathering will be at The Rock.

Diane Merwarth reported that we still need a child care person for walks. She will work with Tom Rioux to amend the current agape list.

Gene McConnell announced that the Lay Director for the Men's Walk in October, 2011, will be Jack Foreman and the Women's Walk in September will be Gina Franklin.

Bob Duplantis reported that based on the information he received regarding our status as a 50-1(C)(3), we are unsure of our current status. Jim Anthony, Bob Duplantis and Roxie Greenway will discuss possible solutions and report back to the Board.

Jack Foreman pointed out that, as Board Rep for the upcoming Men's walk, he reviewed each talk against the expanded outline, and recommended that all Board Reps should review talks against the expanded outline.

Pastor Cheryl Broome discussed the selection of clergy at candlelight. Traditionally, the Lay Director for the walk selected the clergy for candlelight. However, the 4th Day Spiritual Director is responsible to locate the clergy for candlelight. The Lay Director and Spiritual Director for the Walk should coordinate with the 4th Day Spiritual Director that they have selected a clergy for candlelight, or that they need the community Spiritual Director to provide one.

Gene McConnell handed out outline for the CCEC Report of the Board Representative for Emmaus Walks.

Roxie Greenway reported on the recently held Local Lay Director Training. She reported that a CCLI number has to be included on any handout of printed materials. The music team and servant team need to report any copyrighted materials they hand out. Roxie further reported that any food contained in agape must be pillow agape to comply with Camp Young Judea's Kosher requirements.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:04 to attend the gathering. The closing prayer was given by Pastor Cheryl Broome. There were 142 people in attendance at the gathering.
